1. CALL TO ORDER AND ESTABLISH QUORUM:

7. <u>DISCUSS AND TAKE ACTION AS APPROPRIATE REGARDING REPLACEMENT OF BRUSH 1004 WITH PURCHASE OF NEW APPARATUS FROM AMI FIRE EQUIPMENT IN BRENHAM:</u>

Chief Crain made a presentation on the proposed replacement of Brush 1004 for \$179,610 through BuyBoard with possible upgrade on wheels and tires for an additional \$10,000.00.

MOTION: Commissioner Campbell moved to purchase replacement Brush 1004 with wheels and tires upgrade, with total purchase price not to exceed \$200,000.00; Commissioner Stettner second; passed unanimously.

8. FIRE CHIEF'S REPORT:

Chief Crain reported all is going well and all apparatus are in service. He also provided run statistics to date; the Paramedic Program is working well; EMS Chief Milo has resigned and the position has been filled by Erik Schleinkofer; a few personnel have refused to get COVID-19 vaccine.

Motion to adjourn by Commissioner Stettner, second by Commissioner Cantor; approved unanimously and the meeting was adjourned at 7:27 p.m.
