Regular Meeting Minutes September 21, 2022

1. <u>Call to order and establishment of a quorum:</u>

Commissioner Clakley reported that all checks had cleared from August 2022, and that one check was still outstanding from July 2022. Crain will look into the July check. Chief Crain also provided year-to-date financials, attached.

5. <u>Discussion and action as required regarding donation from Michael and Susan</u> <u>Dell, including but not limited to purchase of materials/equipment/facilities for</u> <u>staff usage</u>

The staff have been informed of this opportunity. At the time of this meeting, they had not yet come to a consensus on their purchase request. This agenda item is therefore tabled until next month's meeting.

6. Fire Chief's Report

Crain reported that all apparatus were in service and that all employees were well. The YTD run summary was distributed. Crain reported that bids were being obtained for

installation of shade covers for the parking areas. A proposal will likely be presented next month.
