1. CALL TO ORDER AND ESTABLISH QUORUM:

8. ADOPTION OF THE DISTRICT'S 2025 AD VALOREM TAX RATE OF \$0.10 PER \$100 VALUATION AND AUTHORIZE DISTRICT OFFICERS AND OFFICIALS TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTION TO IMPLEMENT SAME.

MOTION: Commissioner Campbell moved, "I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.10 per \$100 valuation, consisting of a separately adopted Debt Rate of \$0.00 per \$100 valuation and a separately adopted Maintenance & Operations Rate of \$0.10 per \$100 valuation, which is effectively a 3.99983 percent increase in the tax rate;" Commissioner Clakley second; approved unanimously.

10. STATUS OF FIRE STATION PROPERTY IMPROVEMENTS:

This matter was tabled pending further information.
